I am writing to request that each of you send me copy of the “University of California Form for Obtaining Background Information and Conflict of Interest Disclosure for Activities Related to Government Regulation,” that you were required to submit to the UC President when you applied to be a member of the Scientific Review Panel (SRP) on Toxic Air Contaminants (TAC). Please read my attached October 22, 2014 and November 5, 2014 letters to Dr. Kleinman and my November 12, 2014 letter to CARB and the UC President to understand this important request.

As nine UC faculty members, you need to know that the SRP’s numerous unjustified TAC identifications, which have harmed countless California businessmen and taxpayers like me, is a prime reason why public support for UC has been steadily declining.
