Dear Mr. Brown:

I am writing in response to your most recent letter regarding the health basis for the Air Resources Board's (ARB) statewide truck rules. Details regarding the rationale and scientific basis for the effect of PM2.5 exposure on mortality are presented in ARB's August 2010 report entitled "Estimate of Premature Deaths Associated with Fine Particle Pollution (PM2.5) in California Using a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Methodology." As noted in our May 5, 2011 response to you, the ARB's updated report relies on the latest U.S. EPA science and health risk assessments which were peer reviewed by an independent panel of national scientists on the Clean Air Scientific Advisory Committee.

The national PM2.5 risk assessment included estimates of premature death in California using an American Cancer Society study of 500,000 people. In addition, a new report focused on the California participants in that study was recently submitted to ARB's Research Screening Committee. The Committee provided comments indicating that the results show that fine particles are associated with significantly elevated risks from cardiovascular mortality and ischemic heart disease mortality. The author is making the clarifications requested by the Committee, and the final report will be presented to the Committee at the next meeting expected to be held in October.
